

ALTERING OR DEFACING INFORMATION & PERMISSION TRAIL SIGNS
IS HARMFUL TO ALL IN MOTORIZED RECREATION

The following picture was taken of a sign that connects a non-wheeled vehicle trail from the First Cr. 38367 road to DNR land on Cougar Flats. This trail is closed to all wheeled vehicles.



The top part of this sign, before the saw job, had both NO-ATV & NO-Motorcycle traffic allowed. I am sure that someone thinks they were being clever but in fact they are creating a disservice to all motorized recreation users. North Central ATV Club had agreed with the U S Forest Service & the WA. State Department of Natural Resources not to put WHEELED VEHICLES on this trail as it is much too difficult to maintain. You, whoever you are, have just cost the NCA TVC hundreds of dollars for trail reclamation and erosion control on this trail which could have been better spent on ATV/ORV Cattle Guards and other permission signage. If your conscience allows, if you have one, an anonymous donation of about \$ 500.00 to cover the reclamation, erosion control, and sign damage might just ease the guilt a mite.
