

Okanogan County ORV Regulations

Please stay on designated roads and trails or we may lose them!
No off road/cross country travel allowed.

All Jurisdictions - Roads Designated for WATV Use:

- Current WATV tag (see <http://www.dol.wa.gov/vehicleregistration/watv.html>)
- Motorcycle Helmet Required (except for ORVs with roll bar and seat belts connected)
- Proper Eye Protection
- Head lights on day or night
- Spark arrestor exhaust
- Mirrors, horn and turn signals if driving at night

Okanogan County Open ORV Roads:

- See Okanogan County Code Chapter 10.10 Off-Road Vehicles & Ordinance 2013-8
- Valid driver's license required
- Proof of liability insurance required
- Posted speed limit but not to exceed 35mph on open roads

Okanogan-Wenatchee National Forest:

- See RCW 46.09.460 below
- Maximum speed limit 25mph
- Blacktop from FS Boundary to Salmon Meadows is Closed
- Blacktop from FS 37/42 Junction to FS 3700300 is Closed

Town of Conconully ATV Ordinance 304:

- All requirements of WA State RCW 46.09
- Valid driver's license required
- Maximum speed limit 25mph
- All streets open unless posted closed

City of Okanogan ORV Ordinance 1101:

- Valid driver's license required
- Posted speed limit but not to exceed 35mph
- All streets open unless posted closed

City of Tonasket ORV Ordinance 725:

- Valid driver's license required
- Posted speed limit but not to exceed 35mph
- All streets open unless posted closed
- Posted speed limit

WA State DNR:

- See RCW 46.09.460 below (**County roads within DNR boundaries license required**)
- Maximum speed limit 25mph on forest managed roads

WA State RCW 46.09.460:

- Operators under 16 years of age must be under direct supervision of a licensed adult 18 years or older. (**Conconully, Loomis, Okanogan, Tonasket, Okanogan County, 16 years or older with valid driver's license required**)
